

# Have your CNG Cylinders reached their end of life (EOL) date?

The Federal Department of Transportation Standard No. 304 requires a label on each CNG cylinder stating that the cylinder shall not be used after the end of life date as recommended by the manufacturer.

The National Fire Protection Association's NFPA 52 document requires that this EOL date should also be displayed in the engine compartment and at the fueling connection of each vehicle.

FMVSS 304 also requires that the cylinder manufacturer's name, address and telephone number be on each cylinder. If there are any questions about proper decommissioning for the cylinders you can contact the manufacturer.
