WASHINGTON, D.C. – The *2013 North American NGV Conference and Expo* to be held at the Georgia World Congress Center November 18–21 in Atlanta, GA, is set to be one of the largest NGV-oriented conference-exhibitions in over ten years. The three-day event will feature a comprehensive conference, a large exposition hall and numerous social functions for networking.

The program includes breakfasts, lunches, three receptions and other social functions to provide registrants with plenty of time to network, share ideas and collaborate. A reception-dinner is scheduled to recognize the 2013 NGV Achievement Award recipients on Wednesday, November 20

at the Georgia Aquarium in Atlanta. The 10 award winners will be publically presented with their awards by NGVAmerica President Richard Kolodziej and Clean Vehicle Education Foundation (CVEF) President Doug Horne.
